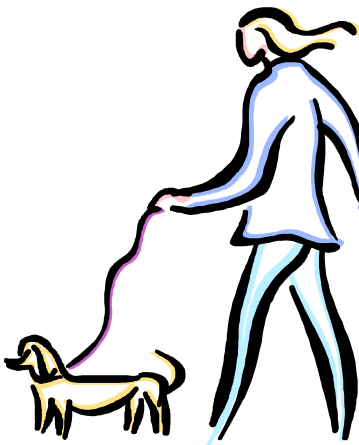

## Training Report – Cheryl Partridge

Classes are in full swing now as we started obedience and one agility class in January and everything else starts in February. We also already have classes booking up for March and April.

Thanks to all the instructors who made the New Year easy on me by letting me know what classes they can teach and when.

In January we had a Novice Obedience, Junior Obedience, Competitive Agility, Puppy Obedience as well as one Beginner Obedience class start. We also had a 3 week Spit and Polish class. In the beginning of February we have a Beginner Obedience, 7 agility classes, and an Advanced Beginner Obedience class starting. At the end of February we have Puppy Obedience, Novice Obedience, Competitive Agility, and 2 Beginner Obedience classes starting. In March we have a Beginner Obedience and Rally Obedience class starting and already in April we have Puppy Obedience, Advanced Beginner Obedience, Competitive Agility, and Beginner Obedience starting.

I want to thank the following instructors and apprentices for helping with all these classes. Rick, Cheryl, Phylliss, Amanda, Erin, Anja, Riekie, Cheryl, Kathy, Vicky, Bill, Lydine, and Melodie. I am sorry if I missed anyone. I also want to thank everyone who helps out with reminder phone calls and doing registrations.

In January we had 44 obedience students bringing in approximately \$1970 in revenue. We also had 8 agility students bringing in approx \$430.

In February we have 45 obedience students bringing in approximately \$2400 in revenue. We also have 55 agility students bringing in approximately \$3100.

So all in all, in January/February we will be taking in approximately \$7900 in revenue.

There are a few spots available in the Beginner Obedience class starting February 24th at 8:30 pm as well as spots available in Puppy Obedience starting Monday February 21st at 6:30 pm.

In March there are spots available in Rally Obedience and Puppy Obedience. Rally starts Fri. March 25th at 7:30 pm and Puppy class starts Fri. March 25th at 6:15 pm.

As well, in April so far there are spots available in Puppy Obedience starting Monday April 18th at 6:30 pm, Advanced Beginner starting Tuesday April 5th at 7:30 pm, Competitive Agility starting Wednesday April 13th at 7:30 pm, and Beginner Obedience starting Thursday April 7th at 8:30 pm. Instructors if you are available to teach in April, please let me know what classes and what days and times you can do.

Again, thank you to all the instructors who have made my job a lot easier by stepping in and taking on classes to teach. You are very much appreciated!
